

Access to Access Course

Did you apply for the Letterkenny IT Access Programme this year but were unsuccessful?

Are you thinking of applying for the Letterkenny IT access programme but are not sure you are ready?

Then why not consider the Access to Access Course...its as simple as A2A!

The **A2A Course** is a new initiative delivered by Donegal ETB's Back to Education Initiative (BTEI) in partnership with Letterkenny Institute of Technology (LYIT), to prepare adult learners for the LYIT Access Programme. The LYIT Access Programme is a preparatory year for mature students who wish to progress onto third level education within the college

This **A2A Course** is intended for adult learners who wish to return to learning after a break in their education and who may wish to apply for the LYIT Access Programme and thereon to third level education. The A2A course offers an opportunity to develop confidence in written and verbal communications skills and a sound introductory knowledge of computer literacy, communications, mathematics and 'How to Study Skills'.

The **A2A Course** is accredited at Level 4 on the National Framework of Qualifications and is equivalent to Ordinary Leaving Cert Level in English and Mathematics. The ideal candidate will have Junior Certificate or other qualification equivalent to level 3 on the National Framework of Qualifications or have taken Leaving Certificate but struggled with English and Maths. Participants should also have an interest in studying at third level at LYIT.

It is proposed that the **A2A Course** will be delivered in the LYIT Campus in Letterkenny from end of September 2014 to end of April 2015 for 11 hours per week (Wed 9.30am to 12.30pm Thurs & Fri 9.30am to 2.00pm). Upon successful completion, students will be guaranteed a place onto the LYIT Access Programme.

BTEI courses are free to all adults with less than upper second level education, social welfare recipients or medical card holders.
