

Get Fit for Further Education and Training with Donegal ETB

Are you unemployed and want to try a short course to see where it might take you?

Are you thinking about studying at FETAC Level 4 or 5 with Donegal ETB but are wondering if you are ready?

Do you have you a Junior Certificate, FETAC Level 3 or equivalent and want to brush up on your English, Maths, Computer Skills and Study Skill in only 12 weeks?

If you answer YES to any of these then the FIT-4-FET course might be for you!

The FIT-4-FET is a 12 week course that is all about getting FIT for Further Education and Training and is ideal for those with a minimum of Junior Certificate or FETAC Level 3.

You may aim to study at FETAC Level 4 or 5, or you may have been out of education for some time and just want to start a short programme to see where it might take you.

The Donegal ETB Adult Guidance and Information Service will also be supporting the course and offer one to one guidance for those who are unclear where to go next.

Course content

Study skills

Learning plans: study planner, research and referencing, mind mapping, assignment layout English

English: written communication, including spelling; speaking and listening; reading.

<u>Mathematics</u>

Maths: number skills e.g. addition, multiplication, subtraction, measurement, money, length, area, volume, perimeter, handling data (e.g. tables, charts, averages)

<u>Computer Skills</u>

Information Technology: online communication (Internet and email); word processing (creating letters and documents)
